To become a Certified B Corp, a company must demonstrate high standards of verified social and environmental performance, transparency, and accountability.





DINNER AT CULLODEN HOUSE



At the time of the Jacobite uprising in 1745-46, Bonnie Prince Charlie used Culloden House as his lodging and battle headquarters prior to that fateful battle on Culloden Moor.

Today, this stunning Inverness luxury hotel stands in nearly 40 acres where you are free to wander about the woodland and private gardens to enjoy the exceptional peace, tranquillity and majesty of the grounds.



PRIVATE SAILING ON LOCH NESS AND VISIT TO ALDOURIE CASTLE

Loch Ness is over 20 miles long, a mile wide and 700 feet at its deepest, it is the largest lake in Scotland by volume. The surrounding area is filled with historic attractions and natural wonders.

The Loch Ness Monster is just one of the many myths and legends to be discovered in this particularly beautiful part of Scotland.

PRIVATE LUNCH AT ALDOURIE CASTLE



Aldourie is the only habitable Castle on the shores of Loch Ness and has occupied this site for hundreds of years. While less than five miles from Inverness, the Estate seems in a world of its own, with an unforgettably atmospheric sense of calm and tranquillity that will soothe the mind and energise the spirit.

Aldourie offers all the fairytale grandeur and glamour you could wish for from a Listed Grade A Highland Castle, with turrets, towers, nooks and crannies aplenty. This is a wonderfully authentic and homely place, blazing with warmth and hospitality, seducing its guests as much with its gorgeous interiors as with its majestic setting.

THE LOVAT LOCH NESS

The award-winning Lovat is a Victorian building located in the loch-side village of Fort Augustus, in the heart of the Scottish Highlands.

The Lovat stands on the site of Kilwhimen Barracks, one of four built in 1718. The west curtain wall of the old fort, 34 metres long by 4 metres high in some places, still stands in the hotel grounds and the monument is of national importance as the remains of one of the four Hanoverian forts built to pacify the highlanders after the 1715 and 1719 Jacobite uprisings.





BAGPIPE EXPERIENCE

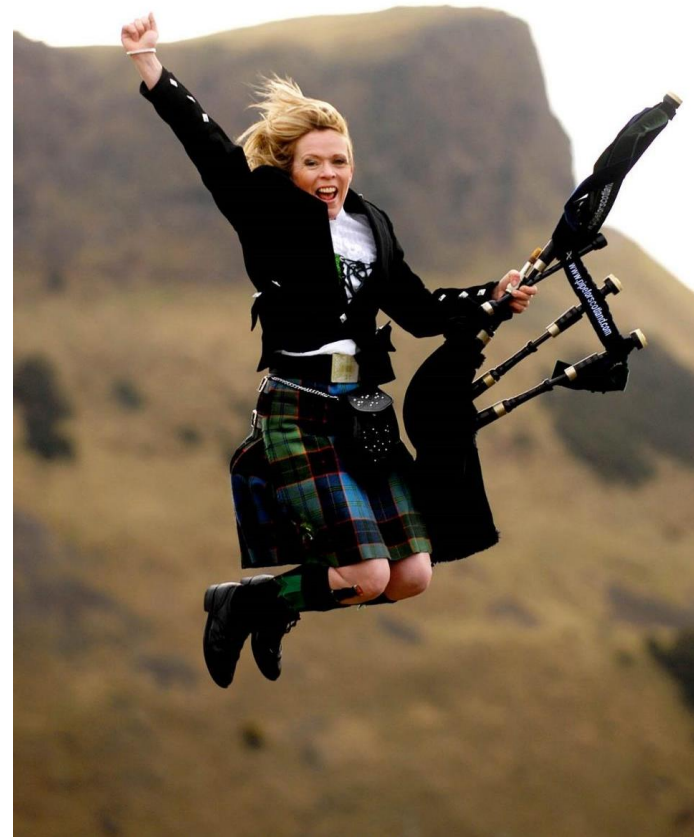
Louise Marshall is very proud to be the official Piper to The Lord Provost of Edinburgh and loves to promote Scottish music, Culture and Tradition.

Throughout her career so far she has had many fantastic opportunities:

- Performing Amazing Grace for Pope Benedict XVI during his State Visit to Edinburgh, September 2010.
- Performed for Her Majesty The Queen at the naming ceremony of Cunard's 'Queen Elizabeth' ocean liner on 11th October 2010.

She is extremely passionate about her instrument and also hosts Bagpipe workshops. During the workshop, she pipes all guests into Dundas Castle in full traditional Highland dress and once seated, all guests are given a chanter as well as music with the scale/tune (Auld Lang Syne).

She then introduces guests to the basic scale and the first few notes/embellishments required to play the first line of Auld Lang Syne on the practice chanter - this is always great fun as well as being very informative!



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Throughout the workshop, she introduces some fun Scottish/tartan for guests to wear - should they so wish, including sporrans, glengarries, feather bonnets, plaids and kilts. She always find guests are up for this! Louise then invites guests up to try and play the first few notes of Auld Lang Syne on the bagpipes, wearing their tartan wear and she forms a 6 or 8 piece band with all the guests playing their instruments, including pipes, chanters and percussive instruments.

As a grand finale the entire group plays 'We will rock you' This really is a truly unique fun Scottish experience! Guests are then issues with a Bagpipe certificate and a small Scottish gift to take home.

This is an extremely fun and exciting 1 hour activity!
