THE WITCHERY

The Witchery by the Castle is almost as famous as Edinburgh Castle itself!

Established over thirty years ago by James Thomson OBE, in a historic building at the gates of Edinburgh Castle, the Witchery takes its name from the many hundreds of witches burned at the stake, on Castlehill, during the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries. It is reputed that more witches were put to death on Castlehill during the reign of James VI than anywhere else in Scotland and the area around the Witchery by the Castle remains deep in history.

This lavishly furnished venue awaits the guests, its gothic touches, velvet-lined walls and flamboyant red and gold décor indicative of the style.

The impressive restaurant showcases fine Scottish dishes in opulent and magical surroundings and has built a world-wide reputation for its exceptional dining experiences.





4X4 SELF-DRIVE EXPERIENCE

After breakfast the guests will be met outside their Hotel by a fleet of Land Rover Discovery Landmark vehicles. They will depart on a self-drive tour of picturesque East Lothian stopping for photo opportunities and refreshments along the way.

East Lothian is a place of stunning coastline, golden beaches and rolling countryside. The guests will depart from the Balmoral Hotel and take the following route:

Drive out of Edinburgh along the coast road through Portobello and Musselburgh, Prestonpans and onto Longniddry

They will then drive across country to Haddington

Onwards to Gifford and then take the scenic country roads to East Linton where they can stop for coffee at a tiny hamlet called Tynningame.

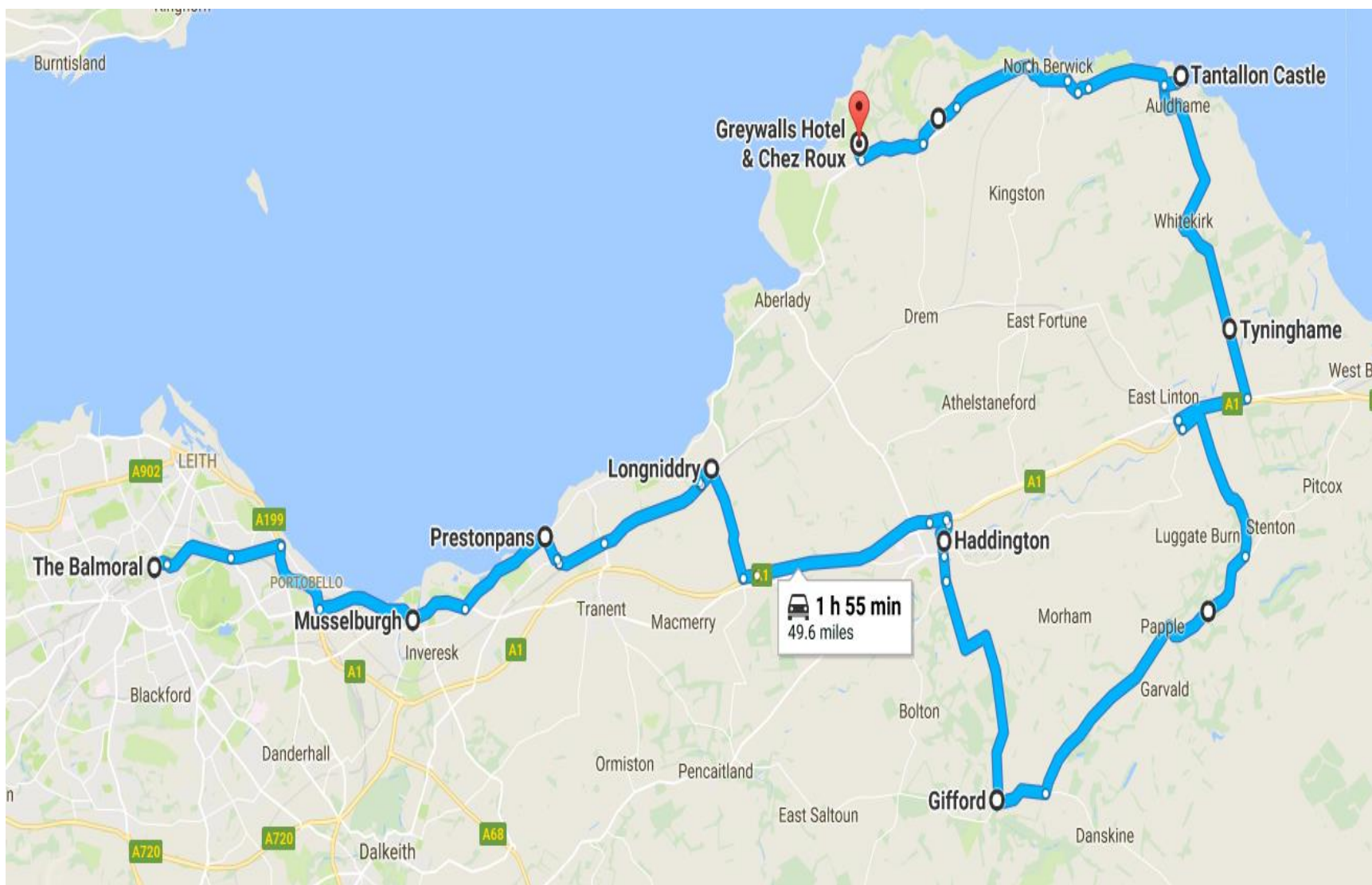
The journey will continue to Whitekirk and arrive at Tantallon Castle – possible brief visit at the Castle

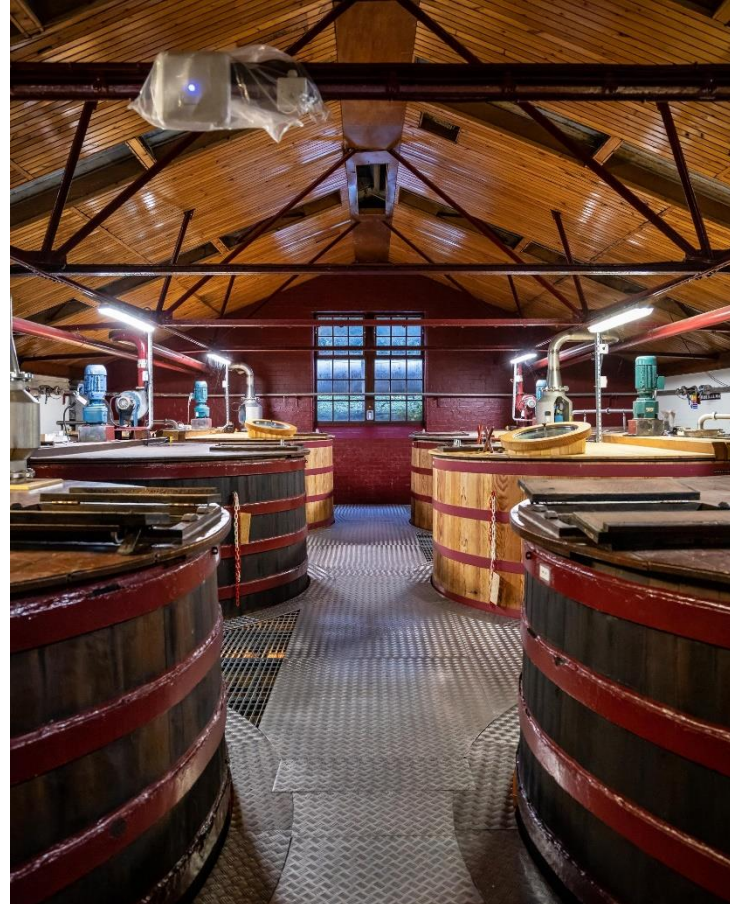
GUIDED TOUR AND TASTING AT GLENKINCHIE DISTILLERY

Glenkinchie is Scotland's most southerly distillery and Edinburgh's 'local'. The malt produced is 'The Glenkinchie', alternatively known as 'The Capital Malt' in reference to its close association with Scotland's capital city.

Guests will be welcomed by a member of the distillery team and invited to enjoy an exhibition of malt whisky on the Malting Floor which includes an amazing model of the distillery itself.

The tour continues through the production areas to discover the whole whisky making process – be prepared for an explosion of aromas!

Of course, no visit to a whisky distillery is complete without a taste of Glenkinchie 12 year old single malt!

To delve deeper, go underground

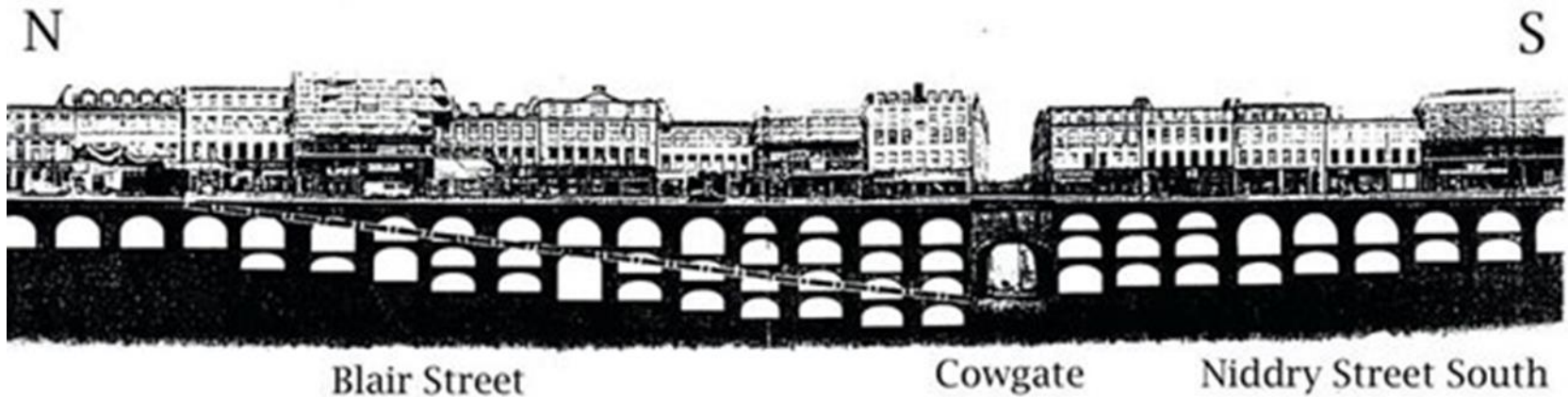
Is it my imagination, or did it just get a little colder?

PRIVATE FAREWELL LUNCH AT PRESTONFIELD HOUSE

Prestonfield House was originally built in 1687 by architect Sir William Bruce, and was once a wealthy rural estate, but in recent decades has come to serve as a luxury hotel.

Prestonfield is a very personal creation, a fusion of historic architecture with an extensive collection of art and antiques and décor every bit as rich and colourful as the history of the house itself.

If ever there were a room rich, ripe and dissolute then the Stuart Room may be it, with its dramatic red, black and gilt décor and luxurious furnishings this is the most striking and dramatic of Prestonfield's private rooms where lunch will be served. The nearby Leather Room makes the perfect location for a Champagne or cocktail reception to meet your guests before lunch in the Stuart Room.

Famed for its views to Craigmillar Castle and its portrait of Mary Queen of Scots, the Stuart Room will seat the guests on one table.
