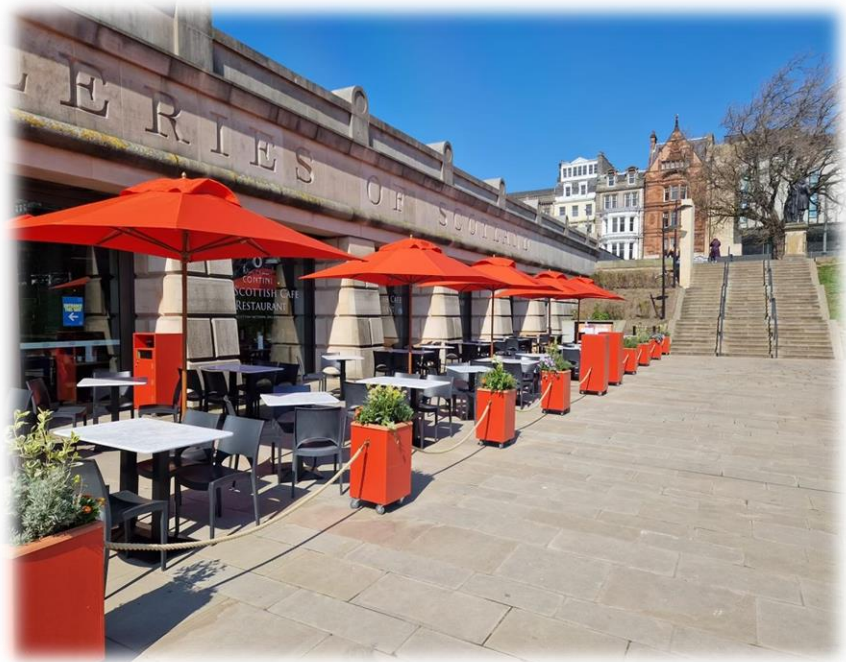


THE SCOTTISH CAFE

Guests will be delighted as they are met by the iconic Red 1960s double-decker bus. The vehicle has been kept in vintage condition, complete with authentic red livery, tartan moquette seating, tungsten lighting and plenty of chrome.
